## STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

## THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (VARIOUS ROADS, PART A WATFORD) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 2023

- 1. The general effect of the order would be to provide 'No Waiting At Any Time' waiting restriction at the following locations.
  - On **Southwold Road**, east side of its junction with the private access car park
  - On **Service Road Q (off Beechen Grove)**, west of the existing Electric vehicle charging bay
  - On the north side of Riverside Road, around the access of Riverside Road Industrial Units and on the south side within the turning circle adjacent to the access of Luterola Close
  - On western side **Perivale Gardens**, around property no. 17 where the carriageway bends north-western direction
  - On the north side of Woodmere Avenue, just east of its junction with Douglas Avenue
  - On the north side of **The Brow**, around the access into **Alban Wood Primary School and Nursery**
  - 2. The effect of the order is to provide 'No Loading At Any Time' waiting restriction at the following locations:
  - On the **Rickmansworth Road**, just off the roundabout with the A411 and adjacent to frontages of the Parade.
  - On both sides of the Service Road Q (off Beechen Grove) to the highway extents

The implementation of the proposed waiting restrictions within the above named order are necessary for the following reasons:

- For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, through restricting parking around junctions.
- For preserving or improving the amenity of the area through which the road runs.
- To ensure roads do not become over congested with parked vehicles causing difficulty for statutory and emergency service vehicles navigating the road
- To prevent traffic from obstructing access points/areas which would otherwise pose a safety issue or raise difficulties with access.

The Council reserves the right to produce an amended or further statement in the context of any public enquiry or judicial proceedings to these proposals.
