Frequently Asked Questions - Larger Black Wheelie Bin

1) There are four people or less permanently living at my home. Can I have a larger bin?

No. The 140litre black bin emptied every two weeks should provide enough space to last each household for two weeks. Make sure you are recycling using your brown food bin and blue-lidded recycling bin. 2) There are five people permanently living at my home. Can I have a larger bin?

Yes - but please check that you are recycling using your brown food bin and blue-lidded recycling bin. Check what can be [recycled online](#).

3) I am a child-minder working from my own home. Can I have a larger bin?

No but If you look after young children in nappies you can use nappy sacks. Find out more about [extra rubbish online](#).

4) There are four people or less permanently living at my home. However, one or more of us has a condition that means we create extra non-recyclable rubbish. Can I have a larger bin?
