

How to find us - Watford Borough Council



Town Hall car park is only pay and display between 4pm and 7am from Monday to Friday and all day Saturday and Sunday

The Town Hall is situated at the top end of the Parade (High Street) on the junction of Hempestad Road and Rickmansworth Road, postcode WD17 3EX

By road - from the M25 clockwise
Leave the M25 at junction 19 and follow signs to Watford town centre, and the Town Hall.

By road - from the M25 anti-clockwise
Leave the M25 at junction 20 and follow signs to Watford town centre, and the Town Hall.

By road - from the M1
Exit the M1 at junction 5 and follow signs to Watford town centre, then follow the ring road and signs to the Town Hall.

By rail - overground
Leave Watford Junction station and bear left onto Clarendon Road. Follow for 400 metres and cross a main junction into the High Street. Turn right onto the High Street and follow for 400 metres. You should see a pond and the Town Hall ahead. Go through the underpass which brings you to the Town Hall.

By rail - underground (Metropolitan Line)
When leaving the station turn right onto Cassiobury Park Avenue and walk to the end of the road. Turn left onto Rickmansworth Road, past the Peace Hospice to the Town Hall.

By bus
142 from Brent Cross
321 from Luton Airport
724 from Heathrow Airport
258 from South Harrow
All the above stop in the town centre, five to ten minutes walk from the Town Hall.

By bike
There is a good network of cycle routes throughout Watford which connect with the Town Hall, and we have bike racks to secure your bikes for the duration of your visit.
