**Re: Proposed changes to parking restrictions on Newhouse Crescent junction with Horseshoe Lane**

The Council has received a request from bus operators and elected members regarding obstructive and inconsiderate parking taking place on the junction of Newhouse Crescent and Horseshoe Lane.

Officers and Ward Councillors have been reviewing the situation in relation to the No Waiting restrictions at the junction. Vehicles have been observed parking on the restriction at the junction causing obstruction and affecting the visibility for vehicles turning in and out of the junction, particularly buses. Being so close to a school, this issue also creates an issue for pedestrians and school children crossing the junction at that location. It consequently creates a safety issue for all modes of traffic.

It is therefore proposed that a No Loading at Any Time restriction is added to the existing No Waiting at Any Time restriction on the southern side of the junction, and the existing No Waiting at Any Time restriction on the southern side of Newhouse Crescent is extended to the existing lamp post. It is also proposed to refresh the existing double yellow lines around the junction for clarity and to mark out the bus stop by the junction on Newhouse Crescent.

A plan (Drawing Reference WR22TRO2118/IF/WD2) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
