<u>Glen Way – Statutory consultation on proposed extension of waiting restrictions and around the</u> junction with Stanbury Avenue

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in July 2022.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to statutory consultation on proposals to extend the no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) by 32 metres on the southern side of Glen Way, from its junction with Hempstead Road.

In addition, issues surrounding parking and visibility at the junction of Glen Way with Stanbury Avenue were also raised by residents and it is proposed that no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) would also be implemented at this junction.

The proposals are shown on the drawing attached (Drawing Reference WR22TRO2118/SC/PK1) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on Friday **23rd September 2022**. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Head of Parking, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to TID@watford.gov.uk . The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 14th October 2022**.

All comments will be considered by Ward Councillors and officers prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
