HOW DECISION WAS REACHED <i>(i.e. factors taken into account in reaching this decision including details of any alternative options considered and rejected)</i>	<p>The criteria for listing a building or land as an asset of community value is set out in section 88 of the Localism Act 2011.</p> <p>This requires that either the actual current use of the building furthers the social well-being or social interests of the local community and it is realistic to think that there can continue to be use of the building that will further the social well-being or social interests of the local community.</p> <p>Or if the building is not currently used that there was a time in the recent past when it was used to further social well-being or the social interests of the community and it is realistic to think that it will be used again for social well-being or social interests within the next 5 years.</p>

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		<p>It is the responsibility of the group making the submission to provide evidence to demonstrate how the building being nominated does further social well-being or social interests. The nomination only referred to usage by elderly residents but gave no further detail of how that then furthered social well-being. The Group provided no evidence on what benefit the pub gave or how busy it was or otherwise fostered community well-being.</p> <p>In addition at the time we received the submission the building was closed and we understand it was sold on 2 November 2017, (contracts exchanged on 20th September 2017) by the brewery to a development company, thus there seems to be no realistic prospect of the building being used in the future for social well-being or social interests.</p> <p>In the circumstances the Council considers that the criteria for listing the Happy Hour has not been satisfied and it will be added to the list of rejected applications for listing.</p>
