### **Riverside Road Permit Parking Area (PPA) – Results from Statutory Consultation**

Further to the statutory consultation process in relation to the proposals for a Permit Parking Area (Zone Z) in the Riverside Road Area, which took place between the 23<sup>rd</sup> September and 14<sup>th</sup> October 2022. I can now advise that all comments and objections received to the consultation have been reported to your local Ward Councillors and the Portfolio Holder for their consideration.

After reviewing the representations made, the decision has been made not to introduce the Permit Parking Area (Zone Z) in the Riverside Road Area. The decision report can be found on the Watford Borough Council website.

Whilst we appreciate some residents did want to see a scheme introduced to deter long term parking from non-residents, the general consensus from respondents, was that a permit scheme is not required, as there is sufficient availability for parking on street, and that issues relating to demand for parking in the area by 'non-residents' are no longer relevant now construction on nearby developments have been completed.

The proposal to introduce short sections of no waiting at any time, around the access of Riverside Road Industrial Works and Lutreola Close, was supported by some residents, and these will be re-advertised in the New Year, to enable further engagement in relation to this specific issue to take place.
