For the 4 May 2023 elections and beyond, you need to bring personal photographic ID with you to the polling station in order to vote.

Accepted forms of photographic identification are:

- ✓ A passport issued by the UK/Channel Islands/Isle of Man/British Overseas Territory/EEA state/Commonwealth country
- ✓ A driving licence issued by the UK/Channel Islands/Isle of Man/EEA
 state
- √ A biometric immigration document
- ✓ An identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS card)
- √ Ministry of Defence Form 90 (Defence Identity Card)
- ✓ A Blue Badge
- ✓ A national identity card issued by an EEA state
- ✓ An older person's bus pass
- √ A disabled person's bus pass
- ✓ An Oyster 60+ card

If you don't have any of the above forms of identification, you will need to apply for a Voter Authority Certificate (VAC) via the Government website: **gov.uk**
