## **NOTICE OF PROPOSAL**

## THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (CASSIOBURY DRIVE ZONE V EXTENSION) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for Hertfordshire County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangement for discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 45, 46, 46A, 47,49,51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act.

The general effect of this order is to:

- Introduce Controlled Parking Zone measures in Cassiobury Drive between a point 50 metres north of Langley Way to its junction with Bellmount Wood Avenue.
- The area will align with Controlled Parking Zone V with the operational hours being the period between 10.30 am and 2.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive from January 1st to June 30th and from September 1st to December 31st (both inclusive).
- Remove the No Waiting 8am-6.30pm Monday to Saturday, located on the east side of Cassiobury Drive, adjacent to Park Veterinary Centre.
