Statutory Consultation on extension to Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) V in Cassiobury Drive, (Between Langley Way and Bellmount Wood Avenue)

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried with residents in February 2023. Ward Councillors reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on proposals to include the section of Cassiobury Drive, which is currently outside of the Controlled Parking Zone.

This will mean that vehicles parked on street, in this area, will need to have a permit during the Controlled Parking Zone V scheme hours which operate Monday to Friday 10.30am-2.30pm, between the 1st September and 30th June.

"Past this Point" signage similar to those already seen on Cassiobury Drive to the north of Bellmount Wood Avenue, will be used to advise drivers of the restrictions. The existing section of single yellow line (No Waiting Monday-Saturday 8am-6.30pm) will be removed to ensure a consistent approach to markings in the area. This removal will also provide an increase in kerb side space for parking. The proposals are shown on the drawing enclosed. Further information on the zone and permit eligibility can be found on the council website at www.watford.gov.uk/parking.

The statutory consultation period commences on **Friday 13**th **October 2023**. As this is a legal process, representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Lead Officer, at the address noted above or by email to parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on **Friday 3**rd **November 2023**.All comments will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and your local Ward Councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals or not. Once a decision has been made, we will write to you again to inform you of the outcome.
