

Single Homeless Pathway – Eligibility Criteria

Emerging Futures – Roslyn Road – Abstinence Project

- Those with low drug problem severity, but high-risk factors of relapse paired with low recovery capital.
- Homelessness, complex needs seeking stability.
- Those who have not previously benefited from previous community-based psychosocial treatment.
- Those seeking abstinence and who have social (e.g., housing) problems.
Be mindful that on making a referral the commitment required. (Residential abstinent project)
- We do accept referrals for individuals currently on a final reduction plan from illicit substances/Alcohol with CGL or other treatment services.
- On referral we will discuss suitability regarding the reduction plan, alongside their engagement with treatment services and Emerging Futures. Engagement is paramount for the individual to be suitable for the project.
- Assessment will be offered on day 1 of abstinence with the intention to move in on day 10-14 if a bed space is available.
- Emerging Futures key workers to work in partnership with CGL to support the individual in their journey to recovery to abstinence.
- Please be advised long term abstinent individuals may not require the intensive intervention programmes.
- Clear communication with the individual on the requirements of the service and the commitment from the individual.
