Dear Occupier,

Informal Consultation on extension to Permit Parking Area (PPA) NA to include Gammons Lane (section west of St George's Road)

Your local Ward Councillors have been contacted by residents who have requested that the no through road section of Gammons Lane (west of St George's Road) which is currently outside of the PPA, should be included within Zone NA.

As you will be aware, parking on this section of carriageway on Gammons Lane is currently unrestricted, which enables vehicles to park long term without having a permit.

To ensure the views of residents in this section are considered, we are carrying out this short informal consultation to understand the level of support from those properties within the road, which will be most affected by any changes.

If there is support for the proposals, this will mean vehicles parked on street will need to have a permit to park during the scheme hours which operates between Monday to Saturday 8am to 10am and 5pm to 10pm (including Bank Holidays).

It is proposed that "Past this Point" signs are used. This would imply that permit holder entry signs would be located just west of St George's Road.
