| 4. To remove Condition 7 from Annex 2 of the premises licence, which reads: 'No intoxicating liquor shall be consumed other than in the area shown coloured pink on the deposited plan'. This condition is outdated and relates to an old version of the layout plans. The premises licence only permits on-sales of alcohol and therefore alcohol sold under the licence can only be consumed within the red lined licensed area as shown on the plans, which means this condition is not necessary.  Permitted hours and licensable activities remain as existing.   |
