THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (KING GEORGES AVENUE ZONE T EXTENSION) AMENDMENT NO 5 ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for Hertfordshire County Council proposes to make the above-mentioned, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Government (Arrangement for discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 45, 46, 46A, 47,49,51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act.

The general effect of this order is to:

- Introduce Controlled Parking Zone measures on King Georges Avenue by including it with the existing nearby Controlled Parking Zone T
- The area will align with the operational hours of the Controlled Parking Zone T: Mon -Sat 8am - 6.30pm Match days only Mon - Fri 8am - 10pm Sat & Bank Holiday 8am -6.30pm Sunday 1.00 - 6.30pm
