## Cycle Parking, Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) – Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the Supplementary Planning Document: Cycle Parking was adopted by Cabinet on 3 July 2017 to be used for development management purposes.

The SPD supplements policies in the adopted Development Plan (the Local Plan Core Strategy and saved policies of the Watford District Plan 2000) by providing additional guidance on the design, size and location of secure storage for pedal cycles and other large items in new developments. The provision of convenient and secure storage at home and at destinations is seen as an important element in encouraging cycle ownership and usage.

Modifications made in response to representations received during consultation are summarised in the separate consultation statement. Other minor modifications were made to improve clarity, remove duplication, update web links and remove some remaining references to old regulatory requirements.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than three months from the 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2017 (date of adoption).
