## NOTICE OF MAKING THE BOROUGH OF WATFORD (CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (CASSIOBURY DRIVE ZONE V EXTENSION) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for Hertfordshire County Council has made the above-mentioned order, pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 and the Local Authorities (Arrangement for discharge of Functions) (England) Regulations 2000 with Hertfordshire County Council, and in exercise of powers conferred on that Council under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 45, 46, 46A, 47,49,51 and 53 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act. The order will come into effect from Friday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

The general effect of this order is to introduce the operational hours of Controlled Parking Zone V (10.30 am and 2.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive from January 1st to June 30th and from September 1st to December 31st into the section of Cassiobury Drive between a point 50 metres north of Langley Way to its junction with Bellmount Wood Avenue and to remove the section of No Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am-6.30pm from within this area.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any of the provisions contained in them, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders, may within 6 weeks of the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose
