**Re: Proposed introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions at the end of the Gullet Wood Road**

Ward Councillors have raised concerns in relation to, the obstructive parking that takes place at the turning head at the end of Gullet Wood Road.

It is therefore proposed to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions at the turning head at the end of the Gullet Wood Road to deter parking and improve accessibility, especially for larger vehicles such as refuse or emergency vehicles that will need the area for turning.

To minimise the loss of on street parking for residents the proposed no waiting at any time, has been minimised to 5 metres, and is adjacent to areas marked by dropped kerbs, where parking shouldn't be taking place, meaning there is no significant loss of on street parking spaces for residents.

A plan (Drawing Reference WRR25/IF/ST1) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
