**DUNNINGS (WATFORD) LTD is applying for the variation of a Premises Licence for
Dunnings Sports Bar & Grill, 76 The Parade, Watford High St, Watford,
Hertfordshire, WD17 1AW.**

If granted the application will allow the following licensable activities to take place:

We would like to extend our licensable activities (Sale of Alcohol by retail, Performance of dance, Exhibition of films, performance of live music, playing of recorded music, entertainment like music & dance, provision of late-night refreshment) hours on Thursday to Saturday on both floors. Currently on both floors we can run all licensable activities on Thursday until 1am, We would like to extend this to 2am. For Friday & Saturday we currently are allowed to run our activities until 1am on the first floor, we would like to extend this to 2am, whereas currently on the ground floor we can run our activities until 2am, but would like to extend this to 3am for all licensable activities.

This would also include extending the opening hours of the business, we would like to extend our Thursday opening hours of business on Thursday from 1:30 to 02:30 for both floors, and then extend our first floor opening hours from 01:30 to 02:30, as well as our ground floor opening hours from 02:30 to 03:30.

[Representations made after the grant of a provisional statement and before the grant of the corresponding premises licence or club premises certificate may not be made if a person could have made the same representations or substantially the same representations but failed to do so without reasonable excuse; and there has been no material change in circumstances relating to the premises or area since the provisional statement was made]. A copy of the application for the grant of the above licence is kept by Licensing Authority at the above address. The application can be viewed Monday to Thursday 9am to 5pm and 9am to 4.45 pm on Fridays, except bank holidays. It is an offence knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for making a false statement is a Level 5 fine on the standard scale.
