**Subject: Proposed introduction of waiting restrictions on Access Road to Garages / Haines Way junction**

Residents, through the Leavesden Community Group Centre, have raised concerns with the Council regarding the obstructive parking that occurs at the junction of the access road leading to the garages opposite No. 71 Haines Way. Vehicles parking at or close to the junction reduce forward visibility for drivers turning onto Haines Way, creating a potential safety risk.

To address these safety concerns, it is therefore proposed to introduce *No Waiting at Any Time* (double yellow line) restrictions at the junction of the access road with Haines Way. This would deter parking at the junction and improve visibility for motorists.

A plan (Drawing Reference **WRR26/IF/WD1**) showing the proposal is attached for your review.
