**Subject: Proposed extension of existing waiting restrictions on Harford Drive/ Langley Way Junction**

Residents have raised concerns with the Council via the Ward Councillors regarding visibility for drivers turning out from Harford Road onto Langley Way. The issue relates to the current layout of the junction where vehicles, particularly large ones such as vans, parking adjacent to the existing double yellow lines can reduce sight lines and be perceived as a safety risk.

To improve the visibility of on-coming traffic for drivers turning out of Harford Drive, it is therefore proposed to extend the existing *No Waiting at Any Time* restrictions further on Langley Way from its junction with Harford Drive.

A plan (Drawing Reference **WRR26/IF/PK4**) showing the proposal is attached for your review.
