Subject: Proposed extension of existing waiting restrictions on Grandfield Road

Residents have raised a concern with the Council about a pinch point on Grandfield Road caused by vehicles parking on both sides of the carriageway near property no. 100 which is also adjacent to an inset parking bay. When this occurs, the available road width is significantly reduced, obstructing traffic flow and making it difficult for larger vehicles, including emergency services, to pass safely.

To address the pinch point and improve safety, it is therefore proposed to extend the existing no waiting at any time (double yellow line) restrictions by approximately 5 metres towards the eastern direction outside property no. 100. This would help ensure sufficient carriageway width is maintained for vehicles to pass safely and without obstruction.

A plan (Drawing Reference **WRR26/IF/NA4**) showing the proposal is attached for your review.
