Subject: Proposed introduction of loading restrictions on Greenbank Road

Concerns have been raised from residents to Ward Councillors regarding dangerous parking on a bend along Greenbank Road, between Nos. 53 and 55, where vehicles are observed to frequently park on the carriageway/kerb which is adjacent to a lay-by on opposite side of the road. When both areas are occupied, visibility for drivers—particularly those travelling towards Holy Rood School—is significantly reduced, creating a blind spot and causing congestion that presents a safety risk.

Although the area in question is currently protected by *No Waiting at Any Time* (double yellow line) restrictions, vehicles, including Blue Badge holders, continue to park there, undermining the effectiveness of the existing controls.

It is therefore proposed to introduce *No Loading at Any Time* restrictions alongside the existing double yellow lines. This additional measure would further deter parking including by Blue Badge holders, help maintain clear sightlines, and improve safety and traffic flow.

A plan (Drawing Reference **WRR26/IF/NA6**) showing the proposal is attached for your review.
