Notice of Application for the Grant of a Premises Licence

Take notice that JD Wetherspoon plc has made an application under Section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the grant of a Premises Licence for The Colombia Press, 72-74 The Parade, High Street, Watford, WD17 1AW.

The application is to provide the following licensable activities:

1. Sale of Alcohol between 0900 - 0200 Monday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday and 0900 - 0000 Tuesday, Wednesday & Sunday. Alcohol sold for consumption on and off the premises.
2. Regulated Entertainment between 0700 - 0300 Monday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday and 0700 - 0030 Tuesday, Wednesday & Sunday.
3. Late Night Refreshment between 2300 - 0300 Monday, Thursday, Friday & Saturday and 2300 - 0030 Tuesday, Wednesday & Sunday.
4. Extensions to the above hours are sought for certain non- standard days, details of which are contained in the notice of application.

The licence is sought on the same terms as the previously held premises licence.
