**Re: Minerva Drive, outside the Goodwood Recreation Ground Entrance- Statutory Consultation on proposed no waiting at any time restriction**

Thank you for your feedback and comments following the informal consultation we carried out with residents between 26<sup>th</sup> January and 13<sup>th</sup> February 2026.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to the statutory consultation stage on the proposal to introduce no waiting-at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) adjacent to the entrance of The Goodwood Recreation Ground on Minerva Drive. This will deter vehicles from parking at or close the entrance to the grounds which raises a safety issue for drivers and people particularly vulnerable ones, accessing the grounds.

The proposal is shown on the drawing attached (**Drawing Reference WRR26/SC/NA2**) for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May 2026. Representations of support or objections to the proposal, together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to Justin Bloomfield, Parking Services Lead, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX or by email to [parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk](mailto:parkingconsultation@watford.gov.uk). The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is **23:59 on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026**.

All comments will be considered by the Portfolio Holder and local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
