

# LICENCES FOR SEX ESTABLISHMENTS NEWSPAPER ADVERTISEMENT

Within seven days of applying for a licence a notice advertising the application has to be published in a local newspaper circulating within the area of Watford. The responsibility of publishing is the applicants.

The Council is empowered to prescribe the form of notice and accordingly requires applicants to follow the format set out hereunder.

Applicants should note that a complete copy of the newspaper in which the advertisement has been inserted should be sent to Licensing, Watford Council, Town Hall, Watford, Herts, WD17 3EX for the attention of the Licensing Officer.

## SEX ESTABLISHMENT LICENCE

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT (1)

### OBJECTIONS

Any person who wishes to object to this application must give notice in writing of his/her objection to the Head of Environment, Health and Licensing, Watford Council, Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX (e-mail [licensing@watford.gov.uk](mailto:licensing@watford.gov.uk)) within 28 days of the date of the application which is given above. The objector must state the general grounds of the objections. Watford Council will NOT reveal the name of the objectors without their consent.

- (1) Insert the full name of applicant in block capitals
- (2) Insert the date upon which the application was delivered to the Borough Council.
- (3) Delete alternatives as appropriate.
- (4) Delete as appropriate. When the application is in respect of premises the address must be given in block capitals. In the case of the other, the applicant must specify using block capitals where it is used as a sex establishment.
