

Non-Commercial Street Activities Consent Standard Conditions

- 1. The activities to take place at **[insert authorised location]**.
- 2. Access and egress for pedestrians and into or out of buildings is to be maintained at all times.
- 3. No vehicles may be parked or driven into pedestrianised areas unless The Parking Shop has granted a waiver (telephone 01908 223508). A small administrative charge is made for this.
- 4. You should contact our Transportation section on 01923 278271 to arrange for bollards to be removed to gain vehicle access to St Mary's Square or The Parade.
- 5. You must comply with any directions of the Council's authorised officers or any Police Constable/Community Support Officer.
- 6. No street furniture such as lamp-posts or benches may be used to display articles.
- 7. No collection or money or sale of goods may take place unless a separate street collection permit or street trading consent has been granted. These must be clearly displayed and produced on request to anyone who asks to see it.
- 8. Stalls and displays must not be placed across or within one metre of any cycle route/track or fire hydrant.
- 9. Stalls must be erected, used and dismantled in a way not likely to cause injury or danger.
- 10. Any electrical equipment must be maintained and used in accordance with the Electricity at Work Regulations 1990.
- 11. The name of your charity must be clearly displayed for members of the public to see.
- 12. No activities may cause offence to any person.
- 13. A certificate of Third Party/Public Liability Insurance in the minimum sum of £5million must be forwarded to the council prior to the start of activites or this permission will be cancelled.
