Random Café Community Interest Company	£1,870	<p>A community café using waste food donations from supermarkets. We supplied hot fresh meals, snacks, hot drinks and cakes to those in need in the local community. Any fruit, veg and cupboard items we have left are offered to customers in our mini market. Our service is offered on a Pay As You Feel basis - customers can donate anything from just a few pennies to several pounds for the food, making it accessible to those on the lowest incomes. We are currently running a pop up pay-as-you-feel shop with produce donated by supermarkets and other food based organisations.</p> <p>We now have a permanent site that we are developing. This will house:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a fulltime café • shop • growing space, for on-site produce • Space for social, educational and craft groups
Watford Sheltered Workshop	£2,400	<p>Our supportive employment project provides paid employment as well as functional education and life skills training to local adults with many forms of disability including learning, physical and sensory. Service users complete work in hand packing and light assembly for commercial customers. This develops their skills, confidence, and self-esteem and gives them a life which they and their families would not have thought possible before coming to us. We have been delivering this project since the 1960s.</p>
Watford & Three Rivers Refugee Partnership	£2,689	<p>Funding requested to continue to provide clients with reusable hybrid nappies and to start providing reusable period products to our beneficiaries who have periods. These period products will be: reusable day pads, reusable night pads, and menstrual cups.</p>
StrongMen	£3,000	<p>Our main two bereavement services are the Weekender and Man2Man. The weekender is a weekend break for men who have suffered a bereavement where they can meet other men, participate in some physical exercise and form</p>

Watford Jazz Junction	£2,430	Funding to provide 3 Jazz concerts in Watford. The Jazz of Dudley Moore by the Chris Ingham Quartet. The Music of Cannonball Adderley by the Tony Kofi Trio. Watford Jazz Junction launch with Adrian Cox and Tomorrow's Warriors. We are requesting £2430 through the Small Grants Fund to break down as contributions to each of the events to cover venue hire/kit hire/sound engineering support and some publicity costs to deliver these.
Disability Watford	£1,824	Funding has been requested to help towards general running costs as the organisation has been unable to fundraise or take face to face collections in the normal way during the Covid-19 pandemic.
West Herts Amateur Boxing Club & Educational Support	£3,000	Funding will contribute towards the cost of coaching fees to provide 13 timetabled sessions/week. These will be for children aged 6-10, juniors aged 11-16, seniors aged 16+ and women only sessions.
Dignify	£2,400	The organisation would like funding to support the Dignify Community Pledge - The pledge is to champion healthy relationships and recognise that pornography has a harmful impact on children and young people, perpetuating cultures of sexual abuse, objectification and harassment.
Herts Inclusive Theatre	£2,733	Funding to provide weekly workshop sessions/activities for children with SEND aged 8 - 19 years at the Pump House Theatre including drama, games, scene design, performance, puppetry etc.

Watford Salvation Army	£3,000	Funding towards the purchase and conversion of a tuk tuk into a coffee cart that will in essence become a mobile community centre on wheels for the whole town.
Small Acts of Kindness	£3,000	Funding to source and distribute 120 Warm in Winter gift bags and 120 Purple Pages information and wellbeing packs to older people in Watford.
Playskill	£3,000	Funding requested to purchase promotional materials to publicise the organisation and a contribution towards general running costs to support the delivery of services.
Watford & District Mencap Society	£3,000	Funding towards the purchase of outdoor furniture for the community training café based at Central Library.
One Vision	£2,760	Funding to support the organisation's general running costs and to support its food programme for 2021-22, providing meals and food parcels to members of the community in need.
Cathartic Community Interest Company	£2,932	Funding to purchase a Barista coffee machine to be used in the Cathartic Creative Café every Thursday at the Pump House and will include Barista training for volunteers. Second part of the application is for funding to set up an online creative shop where artists can design and sell greeting cards.
New Hope	£2,574	Funding will be used to support the costs of Cultivate, a new flexible service focusing on therapeutic activities, life skills and practical activities, for individuals recovering from homelessness in Watford. Cultivate will provide floating support both in and outside of existing services. A grant will allow the organisation to run three life skills courses culminating in an industry recognised PAT qualification, two horticultural therapy programmes and a series of floating support sessions to support mental wellbeing at the Sanctuary emergency accommodation.
