Dear Resident.

**Proposed No Waiting At Any Time, Cassiobury Park Avenue.**

Your local Ward Councillors have received requests to review the on street parking on Cassiobury Park Avenue between Gade Avenue and Swiss Avenue. This follows incidents where larger emergency vehicles have been unable to navigate through the area due to parked vehicles on both sides of the road.

In addition to the existing Monday to Friday No Waiting restrictions, it is proposed that sections of no waiting at any time restrictions (double yellow lines) are implemented, to enable vehicles to pass and improve access and road safety, similar to that seen on Cassiobury Park Avenue between Rickmansworth Road and Shepherds Road.

The proposals are shown on the enclosed plan. (Drawing Reference TRO/21/117). As local residents, we are seeking your views on these proposals prior to undertaking any formal consultation. Upon completion of the consultation we will share results with your local ward councillors for a decision on whether or not to proceed with the proposals, if there is support for the proposal, a further statutory consultation stage will be carried out and we will write to you again when this occurs.
