WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Watford being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of article 4(4) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended, are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below should not be carried out on the following address, unless permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended: **18 Chalk Hill.**

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by article 4 (1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995 as amended hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule below.

THIS DIRECTION is made under article 4 (1) of the said Order and, in accordance with the article 5 (4), shall remain in force until 19th March 2014 (being six months from the date of this Direction) and shall then expire unless prior to that date it has been confirmed by the Council.

SCHEDULE

Part 2 Class C: The painting of the exterior of any building or work.

Part 31 Class A: Any building operation consisting of demolition of a building.


