Dear Resident,

Proposed removal of No Waiting restrictions in the Sandringham Road Area.

We have received a number of requests from residents in your area, to ensure parking on street can be maximised for local residents. Having reviewed all the existing restrictions in the area, we have found that a number of historic no waiting restrictions could potentially be removed, therefore increasing capacity for on street parking.

During the national lockdowns the Council did not enforce these no waiting restrictions and it was accepted that residents could park on these, no issues in relation to obstruction or traffic flow where reported during this time.

The proposals include removing the sections of No Waiting Monday-Friday 9am-11am, No Waiting Monday-Friday 8am-6.30pm and reducing sections of No Waiting At Any Time, in Sandringham Road, Osborne Road, Windsor Road & Buckingham Road, as shown on the enclosed plan.

Where appropriate, no waiting at any time restrictions will remain to ensure driver visibility and access can be maintained. For example around junctions or outside the Sub Station. In addition restrictions will remain on Sandown Road as this road is used by larger vehicles accessing business premises.

As local residents, we are seeking your views on these proposals and whether you would support the restrictions being removed. Your views are important and all responses received will be reviewed with the Head of Transport & Infrastructure and Portfolio Holder, prior to making any decision to remove or retain the restrictions.
