**Re: Proposed introduction of No Waiting At Any Time on Forest Road junction with Haines Way**

The Council has received requests from residents and ward councillors regarding the parking which occurs at the junction of Forest Road and Haines Way. This reduces visibility for drivers using the area and can block the dropped kerbs where pedestrians cross.

To ensure the safe passage of vehicles and pedestrians and in the interest of road safety it is proposed that the no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) is introduced around the junction. A plan (Drawing Reference WRR21/TRO/IF/WD5) showing the proposals is attached for your review.
