Proposed extension and conversion of waiting restrictions on Nascot Wood Road & Baytree Walk junction – Statutory Consultation

Thank you for your feedback and comments, following the informal consultation we carried out with residents in December 2021.

Ward Councillors and officers reviewed all feedback received from the informal consultation and have agreed to proceed to statutory consultation on proposals to extend the no waiting at time (double yellow lines) restriction at the junction of Baytree Walk and Nascot Wood Road is extended into Baytree Walk, and to replace the exisiting No Waiting Mon-Fri 8.30-10am and 2.30-4pm on Nascot Wood Road with a No Waiting At Any Time (double yellow lines) restriction. The proposals are shown on the drawing attached for your information.

The statutory consultation period commences on the 19th February for a period of 21 days. We again invite representations of support or objections to the proposal, as part of this consultation. Objections together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent **in writing** to Andy Smith Head of Transport & Infrastructure, either at the Town Hall, Watford, WD17 3EX, or by email to <a href="ID@watford.gov.uk">ID@watford.gov.uk</a>. The deadline for the receipt of objections or representations of support is 23:59 on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

All comments of support and objection will be considered by the Head of Transport & Infrastructure along with your local ward councillors prior to any decision being made on whether to implement the proposals.
