Cycling in Cassiobury Park

Cassiobury Park is very popular with cyclists and they share the park with those of all ages and abilities. Please cycle carefully so that everyone can enjoy their visit.

Cycle paths

There are some cycle paths but most paths are shared. That means cyclists and pedestrians share the same paths.

Share with care

You will see these SHARE WITH CARE signs throughout the park. Slow down to walking pace where the paths are crowded. Take extra care when passing children, people with limited mobility and those walking dogs.



On narrow paths or at congested bottlenecks, be prepared to dismount and walk.

Safe cycling

- Keep your speed down when approaching others and allow plenty of space to pass
- Take extra care when passing children and dogs
- Be particularly careful in busy areas where space is limited:
 - At junctions, bends and entrances to paths
 - By children's play areas including the paddling /splash ponds
 - At the bottleneck over the Rustic Bridge (over the river) and Iron Bridge (over the canal)
 - Near the cafes, bandstand and miniature railway
- Ride in single file if you are in a group and on a shared path
- Use your lights in dull weather and when it's dark and wear high-visibility clothing
- Put a bell on your bike and give two rings to let people know you are there, not as an order to get out the way. Then say thank you, it makes the park a friendlier place!
